

MTK's and SLC's key messages for the Brussels farmersdemonstration on 18.12.2025

- An EU Multiannual Financial Framework (MFF) from 2028 onwards that supports investment certainty, a functioning internal market, food security, competitiveness, farmers' incomes and vibrant rural areas.
- A strong and common EU agricultural policy with a sufficient, independent and inflation-adjusted budget.
 - o Agriculture and food security must also be maintained in less-favoured areas.
 - o Support for active food production, family farms and young farmers.
 - Maintaining coupled support at its current level.
 - A payment cap is needed, but degressivity must not undermine the viability of family farms.
 - Rewarding frontrunners in food chain sustainability and paying environmental support above the minimum EU legislative requirements.
 - A well-functioning food chain: improving farmers' position, eliminating unfair practices and increasing transparency.
 - Voluntary and flexible risk management tools for agriculture.
 - o Smart, targeted incentives for innovation, sustainability and investments.
- Fair and transparent international trade, with protection of EU standards and sensitive sectors.
 - Growth in food exports and improved competitiveness of the sector on global markets.
- Genuine legislative simplification, with changes and benefits reaching farm level; common sense solutions for the Nature Restoration Regulation, the EU Deforestation Regulation (EUDR) and fertilizer CBAM.
- Recognition of the challenges at the EU's eastern external border and support for the vitality of affected regions.
